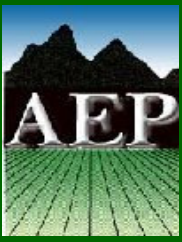
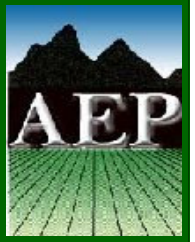


AEP BP Oil Spill Educational Event

- WHAT:** To discuss the BP oil spill and its implications for future exploration and development offshore California. This event features former Bay Area VP Morty Prisament as Moderator, who has worked with both State and local government on coastal and offshore energy siting issues. Morty will be joined by other energy policy planners to discuss some of the important questions confronting the State and nation in the wake of the BP Spill. The panel will review California's experience with offshore energy development, key policy and regulatory issues, and key questions and policy options moving forward.

- WHO:** Speaker #1 Devorah Ancel is an attorney for the Sierra Club where she coordinates the organization's legal response to the BP oil spill in the Gulf of Mexico. Devorah is working to shape a legal strategy that holds BP fully accountable for the destruction of the Gulf, ensures a comprehensive and long-term plan for Gulf restoration, and forces the government to tighten offshore drilling restrictions to prevent future oil spill disasters and ultimately move our nation beyond oil. Devorah also coordinates and manages the Sierra Club's litigation docket comprised of approximately 100 new lawsuits each year.
Speaker #2 Morty Prisament has had a long-standing interest in coastal management and ocean policy issues. He has experience working for state and local government on energy and wastewater policy and siting throughout Coastal California. He worked on controversial ocean wastewater tunneling projects and transborder environmental issues in San Diego, offshore oil leasing and development issues in Ventura and San Luis Obispo, and marine terminal and refinery issues in Richmond, California.
