

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, incorporated in California in 1905, is one of the largest combination natural gas and electric utilities in the United States. Based in San Francisco, the company is a subsidiary of [PG&E Corporation](#).

There are approximately 20,000 employees who carry out Pacific Gas and Electric Company's primary business—the transmission and delivery of energy. The company provides [natural gas](#) and [electric service](#) to approximately 15 million people throughout a 70,000-square-mile service area in northern and central California.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company and other utilities in the state are regulated by the California Public Utilities Commission. The [CPUC](#) was created by the state Legislature in 1911.

PG&E is currently looking for an Environmental Services Manager for the Humboldt Bay Power Plant in Eureka.

Responsibilities:

- Lead and manage a work group that performs technical and oversight activities and reporting necessary to demolish, decommission and remediate the Humboldt Bay Power Plant (HBPP) site.
- This is to be done in a manner that ensures excellence in performance and compliance with all applicable rules, regulations and specifications established by the Company, industry setting groups, manufacturers and State and Federal agencies.
- Areas of Technical responsibility include hazardous materials and waste management, water and air quality management, radiochemistry, biological and wetlands mitigation, soil and groundwater remediation, NPDES permitting, Cal EPA Department of Toxic Substances control permitting, RCRA waste management, Air Pollution Control District permitting, and the Receiving Water Monitoring Program.
- Also responsible for oversight and execution of all activities required to obtain all permits necessary for decommissioning HBPP nuclear and fossil plants and supporting structures. Liaise and maintain good working relations with the local community, regulatory agencies such as the California Coastal Commission, Regional Water Quality Control Board, Cal EPA Department of Toxic Substances and Control, California Department of Fish and Game, Nuclear Regulatory Commission, North Coast Unified AQMD, etc.
- Oversee all environmental work and activities conducted by environmental consultants and environmental specialists working at the HBPP site. Coordinate issues and activities with other site tenants (HBGS, Transmission) to minimize confusion and problems.
- Maintain qualifications, participate in and support the emergency plan in the preparations, drills and actual emergency response. This duty will include being on call to respond on a 24 hour basis during scheduled periods. Fulfill the Emergency Response Organization duties as assigned.
- Responsible for Personal development, continuous improvement of leadership and technical skills; e.g., attend appropriate Industry meetings in areas assigned; attend Tech staff training, attend pertinent workshops, seminars, etc., related to assigned areas and leadership.

Minimum Requirements:

- 8 years in responsible positions related to management of power generation and/or multidiscipline environmental program management. A maximum of three years of the experience may be fulfilled by satisfactory completion of academic or related training
- Proven effective communication skills to all organizational levels
- Proven strong leadership skills and the ability to build teams

- Strong experience in coaching and developing others
- Open to Change and be a change agent
- Ability to provide sound judgment and problem solving skills

Desired:

- 3 years of experience in power plants of which specific radiochemistry experience at an operating nuclear power plant would be desirable
- BA/BS degree in Chemistry or Chemical Engineering, or similar education /experience/ background
- Knowledge of effluent and waste management - hazardous and radioactive gas, liquids and solids and NPDES, Title V, and other relevant permits
- Knowledge of applicable regulations, regulatory guides, and industry standards and guidelines
