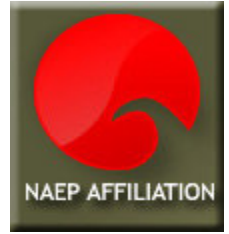

Prior to lobbying, Allan's professional career included public policy positions with local and state government, including the California Coastal Commission, the Governor's Office of Planning and Research and the State Legislature. Allan's legislative experience is based on 12 years working as a Committee Consultant to the Assembly Committee on Ways and Means. During this time Allan was responsible for the review and analysis of legislative proposals affecting the policy areas mentioned above as well as the annual state budgets for state and local agencies responsible for implementing such laws.

Allan was born and raised in southern California; earned degrees in Architecture and Landscape Architecture from U.C. Berkeley; began his professional career in a prominent San Francisco environmental consulting firm; and has been a resident of Sacramento and a State Capital regular since 1977.
